This Week

We have been learning the fairy tale – The Three Billy Goats Gruff. The children have had the opportunity to act out the story and build bridges for the goats to cross. We have also been reading the story, Little Red Riding Hood. We have drawn maps to get to help us arrive at different locations.

In maths, we have been focussing on number bonds to 10 and finding one less. The children are increasing in confidence when recalling their number bonds and they are using the skills I have taught them to find one less.

Next half term

Next half term, we will be looking at, 'What can we see in Summer?' and the topic is called 'Rock Pool'.

We are going to be exploring the season, summer and thinking about what changes happen during this season. We will be learning about the creatures that we might find under the sea or in a rock pool.

We will be learning how to keep ourselves safe in the sun and completing some different investigations with water.

Our role play area will be the beach.

During the first week back, we will be reading the text, 'What the Ladybird heard at the Seaside.'
